Services are provided by psychiatrists, specialty physicians, nurses, master level therapists, discharge planners and other professional staff dedicated to improving the quality of life of our patients.

We recognize the importance of family involvement in treatment. Our programs encourage visits from loved ones, and the social work team is a valuable resource for patient families during their loved ones stay at Haven.

Admission

Referrals are accepted 24 hours a day, seven days a week by calling 623-236-2024. If an individual is not appropriate for admission, our staff will provide the caller with information on available programs that better suit their specific needs.

Our staff will coordinate the admissions process by working with the referral source, insurance company and family to assure a smooth transition into one of our programs. Reducing stress and complications that may occur throughout the process is our goal.

The Mesquite Behavioral Health Unit

Haven's Mental Health Program offers age-specific programming for adults struggling with acute mental health symptoms. Medication management and structured therapy is offered in a safe, secure and compassionate environment. Upon admission, each individual is assessed by the interdisciplinary team of mental health professionals and receives a treatment plan to stabilize their mental health condition. Patient involvement and feedback are encouraged through participation in treatment planning. Therapies include coping strategies, socialization skills, stress management and medication education. The program's goal is to provide patients with the skills needed to manage their behavioral health issues and return them to their best possible level of health.

The Palo Verde Unit for Co-occurring Disorders

Our program offers hope and recovery for adults suffering from both a substance use disorder and a mental illness at the same time. At Haven, we recognize that for treatment to be effective, both conditions must be addressed simultaneously. Our program's evidence-based approach of medical intervention and therapy is effective in treating co-occurring disorders. Detoxification, group therapy sessions, medication management, activity therapies and other services may be part of a patient's customized treatment plan. Regular meetings with an addictionologist, relapse prevention education, AA and NA are essential components of the Co-occurring Program. Patients will return home with tools and social strategies to assist with abstaining from substances. Families and loved ones will be educated on effective support strategies that will aid in the patient's healing.





The Haven Senior HorizonsTM Juniper Unit

The Haven Senior Horizons[™] Older Adult Program provides individualized inpatient stabilization for adults aged 50 years and older who are experiencing acute mental health issues. Each patient is evaluated and treated by an interdisciplinary team specializing in the care of older adults. Our therapeutic environment offers patients the ability to focus on recovery and quality of life. Every patient is seen daily by a psychiatrist and participates in group therapy to learn healthy and effective methods to manage their behavioral health concerns. The goal of the program is to return patients to their optimal level of functioning, and Haven works collaboratively with family and outpatient programs to provide a seamless transition back to home and health.
